1 AUGUST Residential college applications open.

14 AUGUST Application closing date for Bachelor of Dental Technology, Bachelor of Oral Health, Bachelor of Radiation Therapy. Online application only. Late applications may be considered.

15 AUGUST Closing date for most entrance scholarships. Refer to the website for all scholarship closing dates.

1 SEPTEMBER Closing date for Performance Music audition applications. Late applications may be considered.

30 SEPTEMBER Recommended date for submission of online residential college applications, before 5pm. Confidential school references due by 15 September.

31 OCTOBER Closing date for international students (who are overseas) applications. Late applications may be considered if received by 1 December.

10 DECEMBER Closing date for 2026 first year applications. Late applications will be considered.

10 DECEMBER Closing date for Otago Summer School applications. For current Year 13 entry – initially based on NCEA Level 2 grades and supporting letter from principal (Discretionary Entrance).
