Brief Introduction to the Paper

This paper is designed to give students a basic knowledge of Biblical Hebrew, enabling them to use dictionaries and commentaries, and read simple texts. No prior knowledge of Hebrew is assumed. The course is taught both on campus and by Distance Learning.

Assessment

This paper is has internal assessment and a final exam.

- Assignments. 4 assignments worth a total of 20%
- Tests: 2 tests worth a total of 30%
- Final exam: 50%
