

Virtual Reality in Interprofessional Education (IPE)

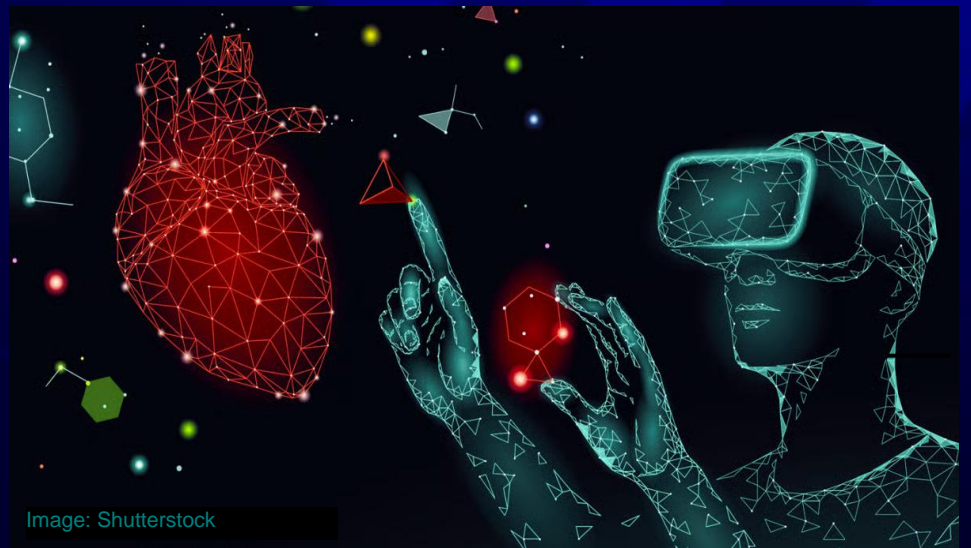

Rita has long experience in teaching and developing curriculum for Occupational Therapy at UiT The Arctic University of Norway and at Bethlehem University. Her educational research links to IPE and collaborative practice, and interactive digital learning with virtual resources. Since 2020, Rita has led the TeraVRi project at UiT. Virtual scenarios facilitating health students' therapeutic competence are developed and systematically evaluated within an interprofessional, digital pedagogical context.

The webinar will focus on the use of virtual resources and digital learning to strengthen therapeutic and inter-professional competence - defined as reliance on awareness of one's values, knowledge, skills and collaboration when acting in professional settings with patients/clients.



Rita will present the context of TeraVRi scenarios (videos with English sub-titles) and the students' impact experiences of therapeutic and IPE competencies. TeraVRi develops students' skills through practice experiences from real-world situations, interactivity with knowledge, and critical reflection.
