The University of Otago provides several parent's rooms around the Dunedin campus that offer parents quiet, comfortable, safe spaces for nursing/ breastfeeding, feeding, and naps. They have a kitchen with fridge, microwave, hot water, and a sink, plus baby changing facilities.
